The presenters shared their expertise and first-hand knowledge of the process that attempts to circumvent municipalities' Home Rule authority.

The seminar explained why it is important for municipalities to respond collectively to Article 10's undermining of Home Rule and touched on what municipalities should do now to ensure their voice is heard throughout the siting process.
